I'm writing to support bill A05468/S3031, which gives parents the freedom to refuse vaccinations based on philosophical reasons.

I am the mother of a twelve-year-old who is on the Autistic spectrum. There are indicators that vaccinations had something to do with his issues. Until I know <u>for sure</u> that these vaccinations <u>did not</u> cause him harm, I will not subject him to further vaccinations.

I know many parents who feel strongly that vaccinations have caused their children harm and they feel the same as I do. The medical community denies the assertions of the antivaccine 'movement' but until they can solidly state that these not do cause harm, I will not participate in the vaccine process. There is a tremendous amount of research, both anecdotal and scientific, that back up the assertion there is a link between myriad health issues and vaccinations.
